

Cedar Nordbye's "Sketchbook Pages" (mixed media, 1997) is one of several striking pieces on view in "Story: Telling," Minnesota Center for Book Arts' first juried exhibition. The show includes work selected from a field of about 200 artists from across the United States and is a wonderfully diverse introduction to the way book artists bend the form. Dorothy Yule and Susan Hunt Yule's "Souvenirs of Great Cities" is an illustrated, whimsically poetic tour of New York, San Francisco, London and Paris in delicate, colorful accordion-style editions. Susan Hensel's sculptural "Bloodlines," on the other hand, is an unsettling piece that features a wooden hand reaching out from a mass of coarse, red-dyed fiber and text.
