

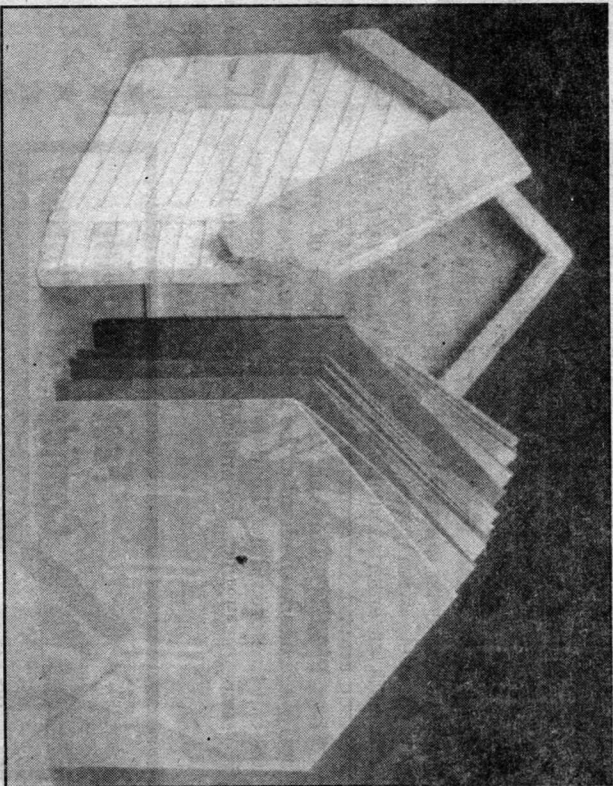
Hensel's art bound for Mexico

East Lansing artist Susan Hensel has been invited to exhibit two artists books in "El Arte Los Libros De Artists Exposition Internacional" at the Instituto de Artes Graphics de Oaxaca, Mexico through November. The show will travel to Biblioteca Mexico, Mexico City in January.

This is an exposition of international artists books from the 1950's to the present. According to curator Martha Hellion, the exhibition is chronologically arranged to show the "different focuses of dissemination and the close relation with the historical moment that gave origin to this form of using the book as an alternative exhibition space." The exhibition coincides with the premiere exhibition of the work of the late Ulises Carrion, an important figure in the development of the artists book in Europe.

The books Hensel sent to the exhibition are *George's Banana* and *Give Me The Words*. Locally, these, and other artists books by

Hensel can be seen through Nov. 25 at Trillium Gallery in East Lansing.
