

East Lansing artist invited to show in Mexico

East Lansing artist Susan Hensel has been invited to exhibit two artist's books in "El Arte De Los Libros De Artistas Expositioin Internacional" at the Instituto de Artes Graficas de Oaxaca, in Oaxaca, Mexico, during through November. The show will travel to Biblioteca Mexica, Mexico City in January.

This is an exposition of international artists books from the 1950s to the present. According to curator Martha Hellion, the exhibition is chronologically arranged to show the "different focuses of dissemination and the close relation with the historical moment that gave origin to this form of using the book as an alternative exhibition space." The exhibition coincides with the premiere exhibition of the work of the late Ulises Carrion, an important figure in the development of the artists book in Europe.

The books Ms. Hensel sent to the exhibition are "George's Banana" and "Give Me The Words." Locally, these and other artists books by Ms. Hensel can be seen through Nov. 25 at Trillium Gallery in East Lansing.
